

Brian Gill Wendler

Brian Gill Wendler has shown extensively in New York and New England, including one man shows at Mona Berman Fine Arts in New Haven, CT and at the 234 Gallery in Wellfleet, MA. Other shows include a two person show with sculptor James Caudle at Golden Street Gallery in New London CT, and several juried shows including Cooper Union in New York city, Discovery Museum in Bridgeport CT, Artworks Gallery in Hartford CT, and Mattatuck Museum in Waterbury, CT. He was accepted for Painting as Presence, Juror; William Bailey at creative Arts Workshop, New Haven, in May 2008.

A diverse educational background includes a BFA from Cooper Union in New York, the study of Minoan Art at the Aegean Institute in Greece, and participation in painting and sculpture workshops with artists such as Joanne Ballinger, Steve Sheehan, and James Caudle. He has also taught art to young children in the Comprehensive Arts Program in New Haven and at Lyme Academy of Fine Arts in Old Lyme CT, and is currently teaching painting and collage at Silvermine School of Art in New Canaan, CT.

Wendler's work is in both private and corporate collections including SNET, Chubb Insurance, CIGNA, PepsiCo, and the Mayor's Art Collection at the New Haven Public Library. In 2006 he was awarded the Artist Fellowship Grant for Painting from the Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism.
